

## Rural Safety Sense DVD - Content Details

The Rural Safety Sense DVD is a versatile educational tool developed for rural youth. As the safety concepts discussed are applicable to all individuals living or working on a farm, this DVD will be a resource for the entire family as they plan and prepare to reduce the risks associated with rural living.

The average farm is unique, as the family and the farming operation exist together. Farming operations may expose family members to a variety of hazards, including:

- Large machinery with many moving parts
- Flowing and standing bodies of water
- Different types and sizes of livestock
- Overhead and underground power
- A variety of chemicals and gases
- Unusual high-rise structures
- Loud repetitive sounds

Planning and preparation are essential in managing risks associated with rural living. All areas of a farming operation should be included in an annual farm safety "Walkabout." Walkabout is an Australian term for trip of discovery. The Walkabout is an opportunity for families to identify hazards and implement effective strategies to manage risks specific to their operation.

All rural family members enjoy the opportunities for fun, adventure and learning their lifestyle provides. The Rural Safety Sense DVD, while developed for youth, is a resource for the entire family as they plan and prepare together, to reduce the risks associated with rural living.
