

A-Mazing ATV Safety

Before you drive an ATV you should take an ATV driver's safety course.

Be sure that your ATV has four wheels. Three-wheeled ATV's are unstable.

Never carry a passenger with you and never be a passenger on an ATV.



Make sure that your ATV is the right size for you. Adult-size ATV's are too large to operate safely.

Never drive an ATV on the road or highway.

Always wear the proper safety gear: helmet with eye protection, gloves, long pants, boots, and a long-sleeved shirt or coat.
