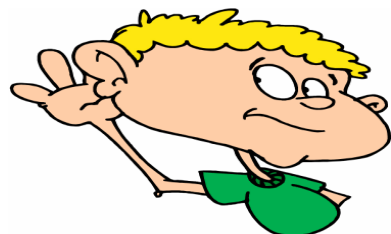

- A. Sound at or above 85 \_\_\_\_\_ can cause hearing loss. The louder the sound, the faster it can damage your hearing.
- B. These fit directly into the ear canal, the narrow passageway between the outer ear and the middle ear.
- C. Ringing, hissing, buzzing, or other sounds in the ear are caused by damage to the ear or brain and is called \_\_\_\_\_.
- D. The inner ear is lined with these. They are so tiny you need to use a microscope to see them. There are about 18,000 per ear.
- E. You can protect your hearing by wearing these over your ears when you are around loud noises on a farm.
